

Hall of Fame Nominations

NOW IS THE TIME TO MAKE NOMINATIONS FOR HOF. Recommendations must be made no later than June 1, of each year. for consideration for January of the following year.

The main qualification for consideration is continuous membership in the Association and any member recommended must have been a member for at least 10 years by January of the year nominated.

Nominees earn points for improving the auction profession at the national, state and community levels. For example, serving on the AANC Board of Directors achieves a certain number of points. Further points are available if the nominee has chaired a national or state committee, such as convention chairman, has conducted seminars without payment or has held any positions in AANC or NAA. Points are also awarded for bringing new members into AANC.

Nominees also receive credit for serving their local community, county, city, state and nation. . Included in this type of work are positions such as volunteer fireman, commander of a veterans organization, PTA, church or synagogue board offices, civic clubs (Rotary Civitan, Lions, etc.), hospital, city council, county commissioners, state house of representatives or senate or a national office.
